## 1. General description

Planar Schottky barrier rectifier with an integrated guard ring for stress protection encapsulated in small SOD123 Surface-Mounted Device (SMD) plastic package.

## 2. Features and benefits

- Forward current:  $I_F \leq 1$  A
- Reverse voltage  $V_R \leq 60$  V
- Low forward voltage, typ.  $V_F = 570$  mV
- Low reverse current, typ.  $I_R = 11$   $\mu$ A
- Small SMD plastic package

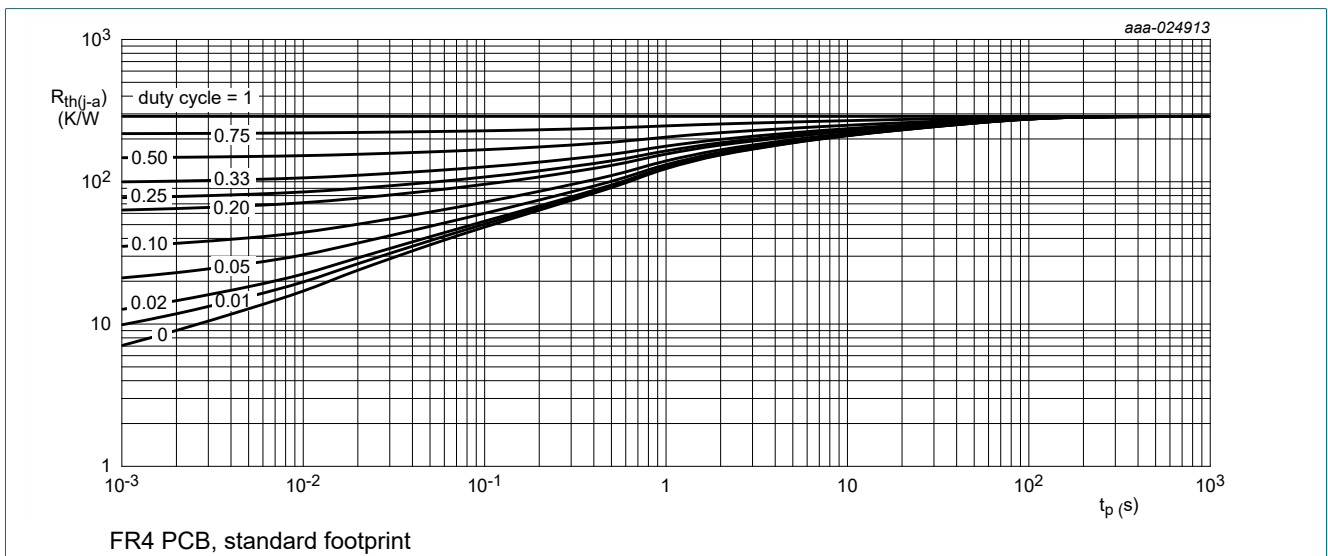


Fig. 1. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values

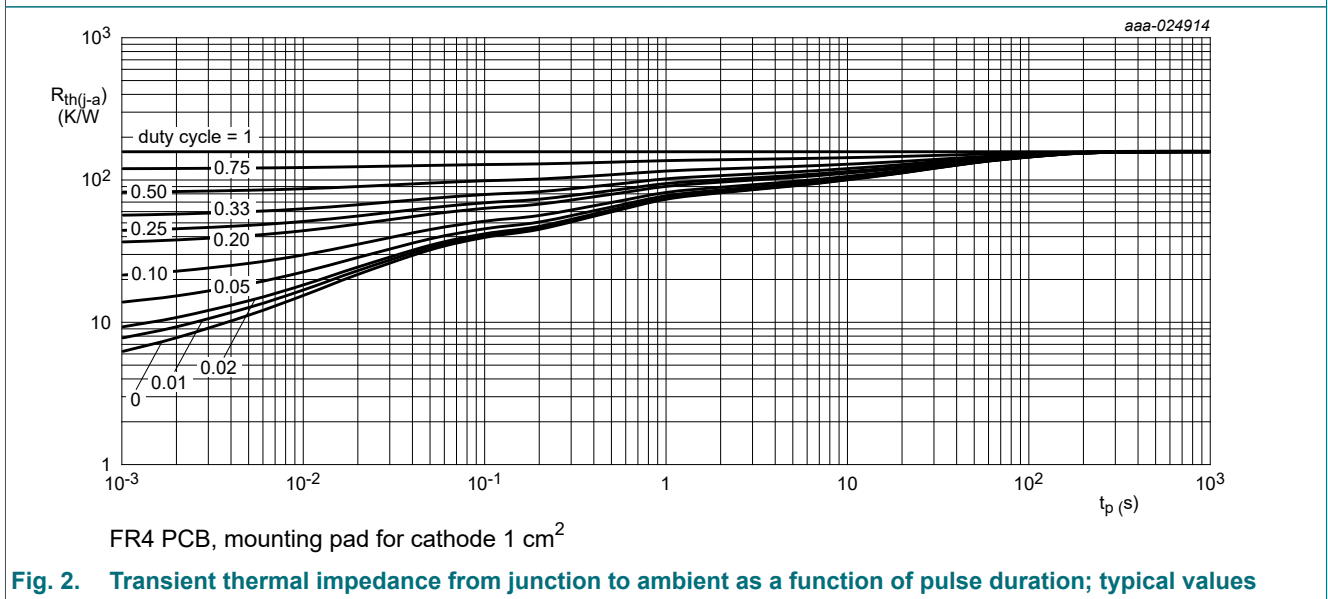


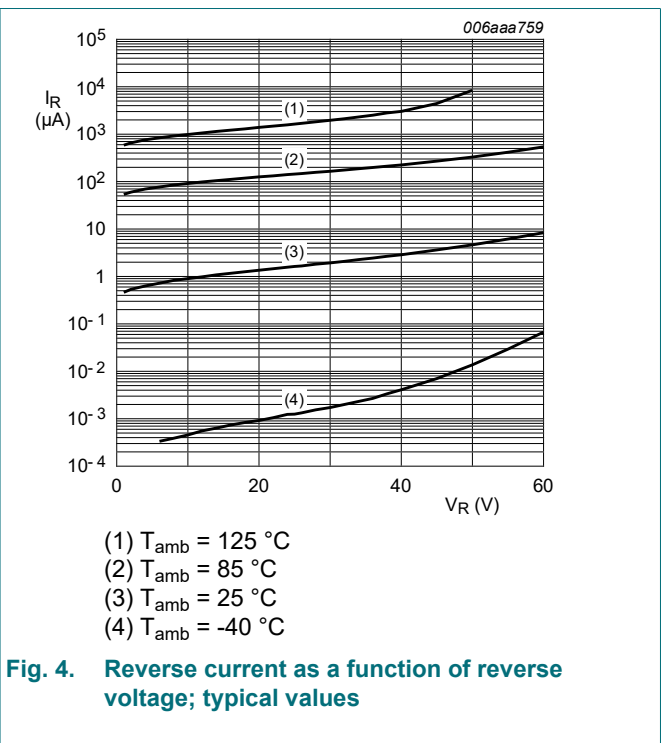
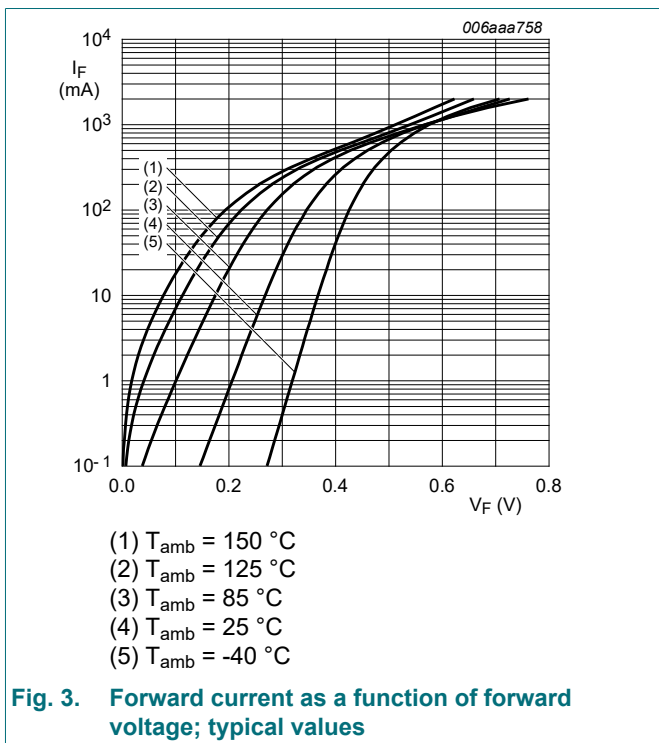
Fig. 2. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values

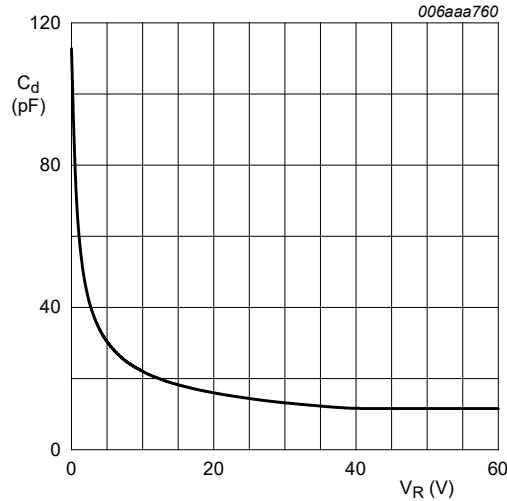

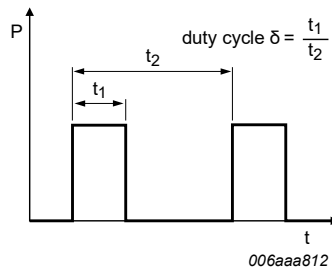


Fig. 6. Duty cycle definition

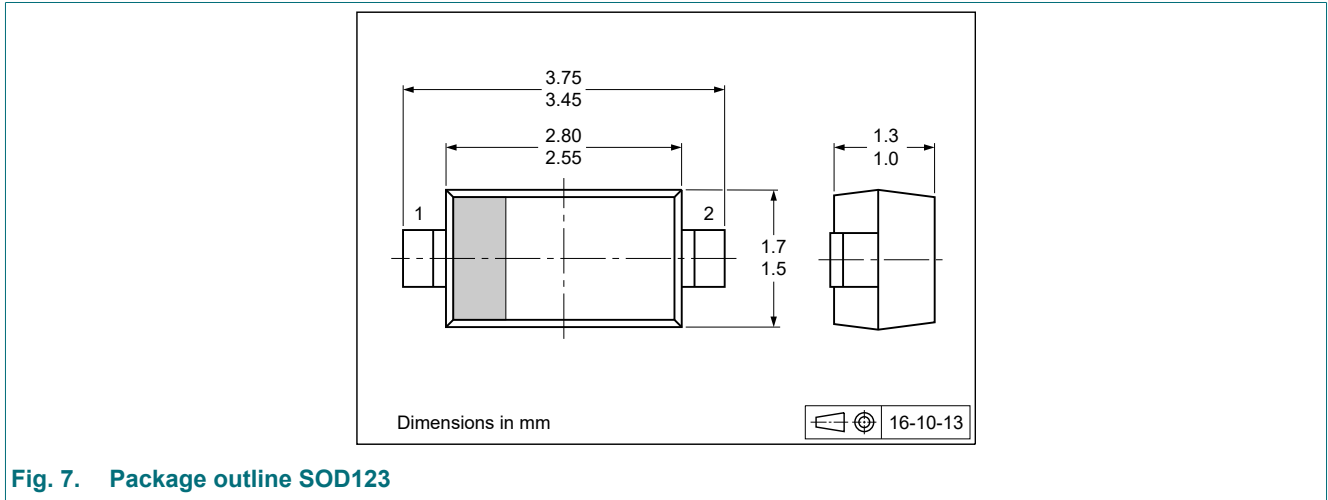
The current ratings for the typical waveforms are calculated according to the equations:

$$I_{F(AV)} = I_M \times \delta \text{ with } I_M \text{ defined as peak current}$$

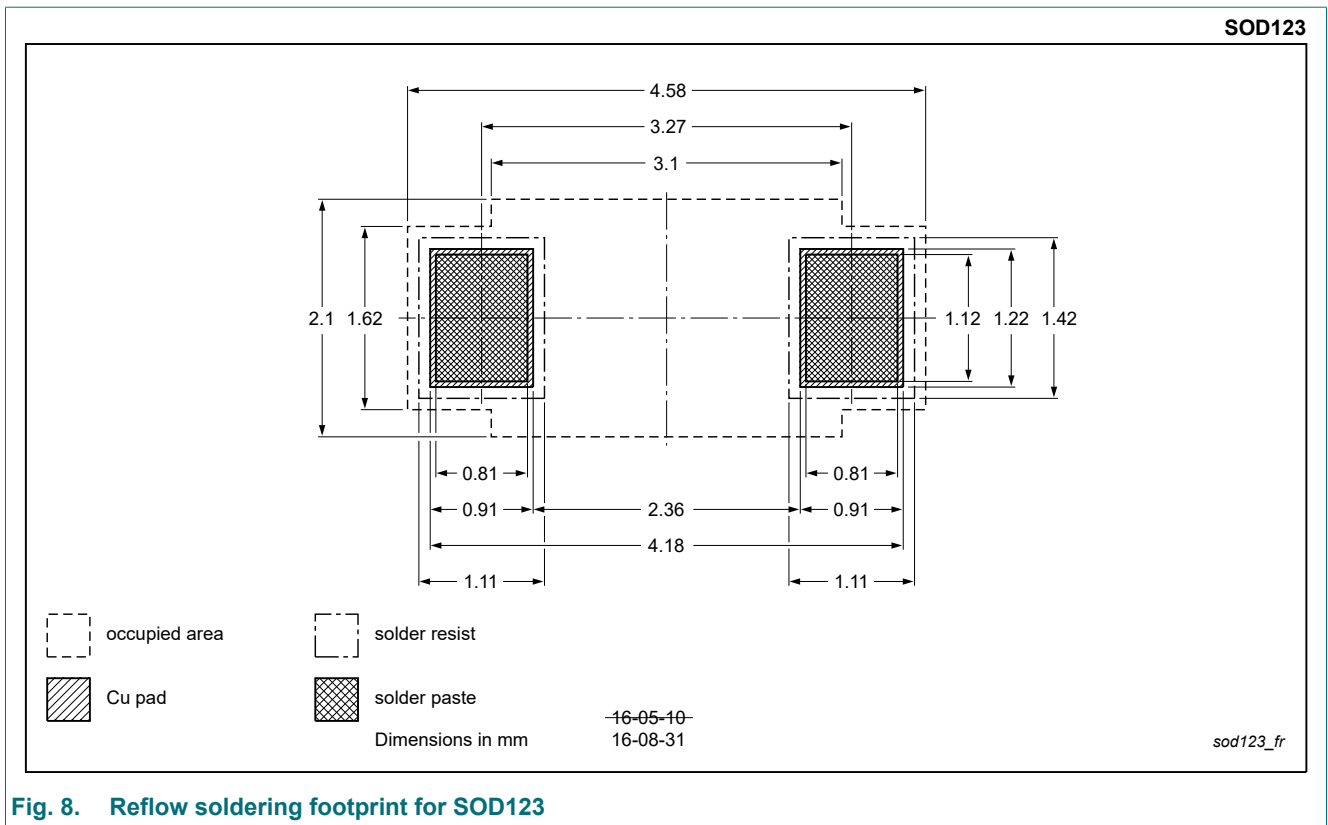
$$I_{RMS} = I_{F(AV)} \text{ at DC}$$
